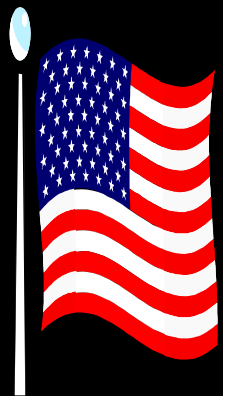

Flood Insurance

Many of you may not be aware that as of 5/31/10, the National Flood Insurance Program expired and has not been renewed by Congress. Without the NFIP, property owners in designated flood zones across Harris County cannot get flood insurance to protect their property. As a result of this lack of foresight, people looking to buy property in a flood zone are not able to obtain a mortgage without the ability to purchase flood insurance.

The month of June began the official start of Hurricane Season. If we have learned anything from "Ike" and "Rita", along with several huge rain storms, flood insurance is almost a necessity for homeowners these days.

As a resident of Memorial Meadows for the past 18 years (and an active real estate agent), I highly recommend that you consider obtaining flood insurance for your home if you have not already done so.

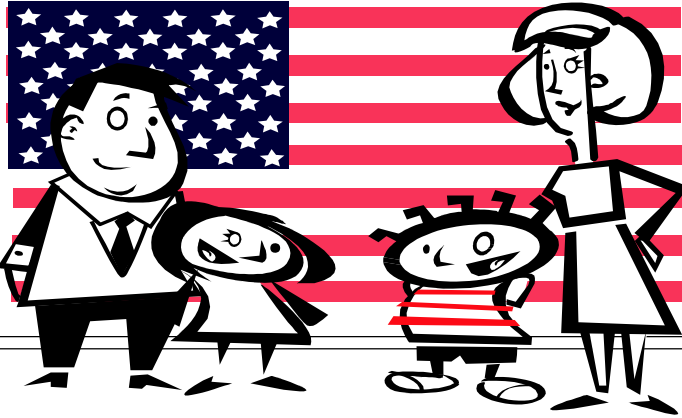
